





O.P. Jindal Global University (JGU) is a non-profit global university established by the Government of Haryana and recognised by the University Grants Commission (UGC). JGU was established as a philanthropic initiative of its Founding Chancellor, Mr. Naveen Jindal in memory of his father, Mr. O.P. Jindal. JGU is one of the few universities in Asia that maintains a 1:10 faculty-student ratio and appoints faculty members from India and different parts of the world with outstanding academic qualifications and experience. JGU is a research intensive university, which is deeply committed to its core institutional values of interdisciplinary and innovative pedagogy; pluralism and rigorous scholarship; and globalism and international engagement.

JGU has established eight schools: Jindal Global Law School (JGLS), Jindal Global Business School (JGBS); Jindal School of International Affairs (JSIA); Jindal School of Government and Public Policy (JSGP); Jindal School of Liberal Arts & Humanities (JSLH); Jindal School of Journalism & Communication (JSJC); Jindal School of Art & Architecture (JSAA) and Jindal School of Banking & Finance (JSBF). JGU has been granted with "Autonomy" by the University Grants Commission and the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India, for receiving the "A" Grade from the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC). This makes JGU the only private university in the state of Haryana and one of the only two private universities in India to be given the status of autonomy.

JGU has made history by breaking into the QS World University Rankings 2020. We are also the only Indian private university in the top 150 'young' universities in the world (under 50 years of age) in the QS Young University Rankings 2020. JGU is the youngest University in the world to feature in both these rankings. In September 2019, JGU was selected as an 'Institution of Eminence' (IOE) by the Government of India, making JGU one of only eight private universities in India to be awarded this status.

LL.M.

The LL.M. programme runs under the aegis of the Centre for Post Graduate Legal Studies (CPGLS). The specialisations that the programme offers are Corporate and Financial Law and Policy, International Trade and Investment Law, Intellectual Property Rights and Technology Law, Taxation and a general LL.M.

The course integrates Indian and global perspectives on all aspects of law and emphasizes on an international, transnational and comparative approach to research.

LL.M. (ENVIRONMENTAL LAW, ENERGY & CLIMATE CHANGE)

The LL.M. programme in Environmental Law, Energy and Climate Change is offered in academic collaboration with the Centre for Environmental Law, WWF-India.

The programme enables the study of environment and climate change through the prism of institutions and laws governing them, with the objective of promoting sustainable development. The programme also focuses on deliberations and analysis of alternate energy solutions, available technical knowledge in the field of environment and climate change and how innovations in the field are best implemented.

This course is useful for law graduates and professionals working in the field of environment who would like to develop specialised legal knowledge on national and global environmental issues to boost their career.

MA DIPLOMACY, LAW & BUSINESS

The M.A. (DLB) programme has been designed as India's first inter-disciplinary social science degree that trains students for international careers and advanced learning in world affairs.

The degree is intended to be neither a totally academic nor a fully vocational one. It stresses theoretical research but insists

on relating it to empirically rich phenomena from the social world. Unlike mainstream Masters programmes in International Relations, which are loaded in favour of theoretical research or 'professional' course work and internships, MA DLB strikes a balance between the two and requires students to be versed in both domains.

A number of core and elective courses in this programme's curriculum have research essay assignments, which are expected to be at the frontier of ongoing scholarly debates and simultaneously accessible to policymakers in India and abroad.
